

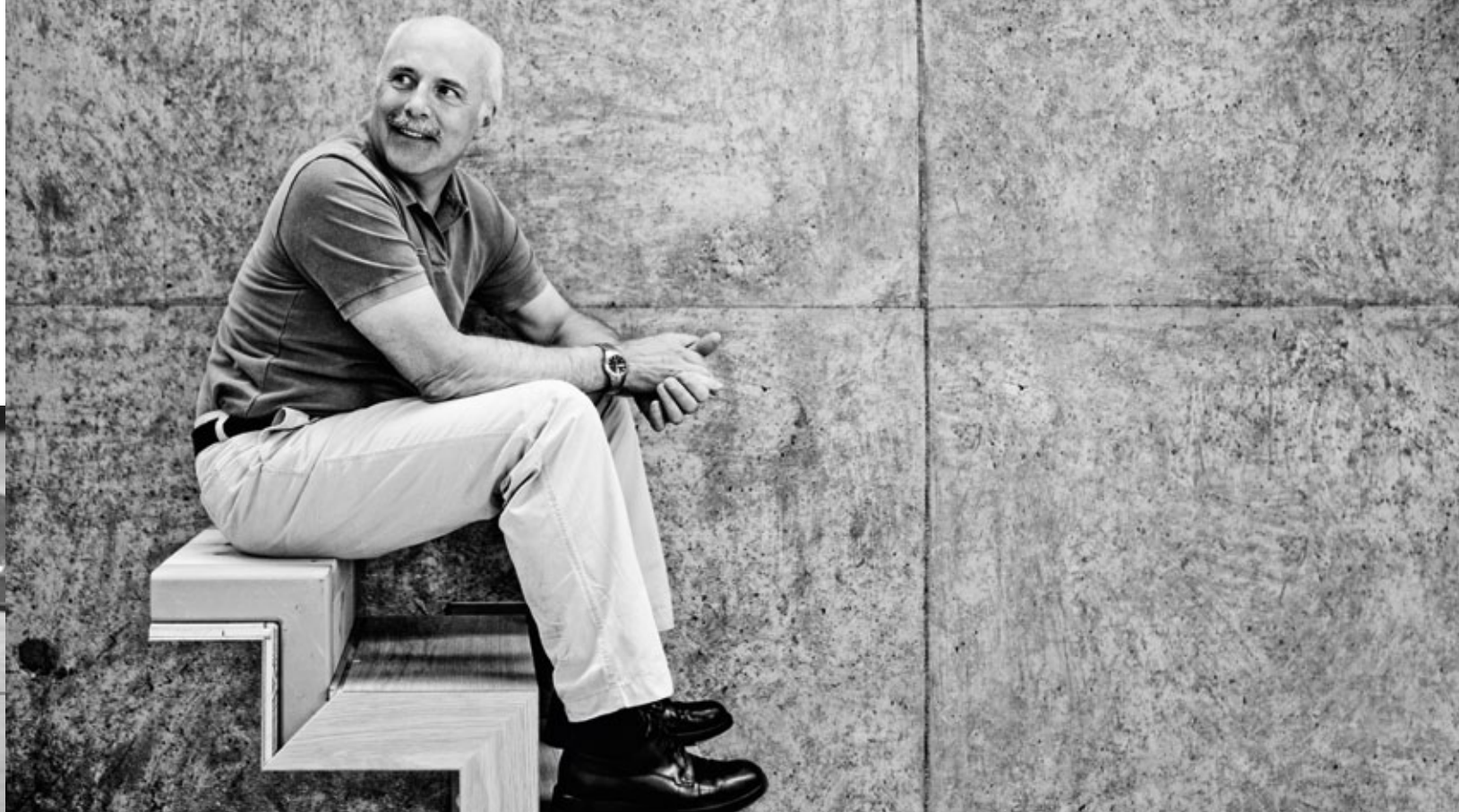

They all speak a common language: interior elements

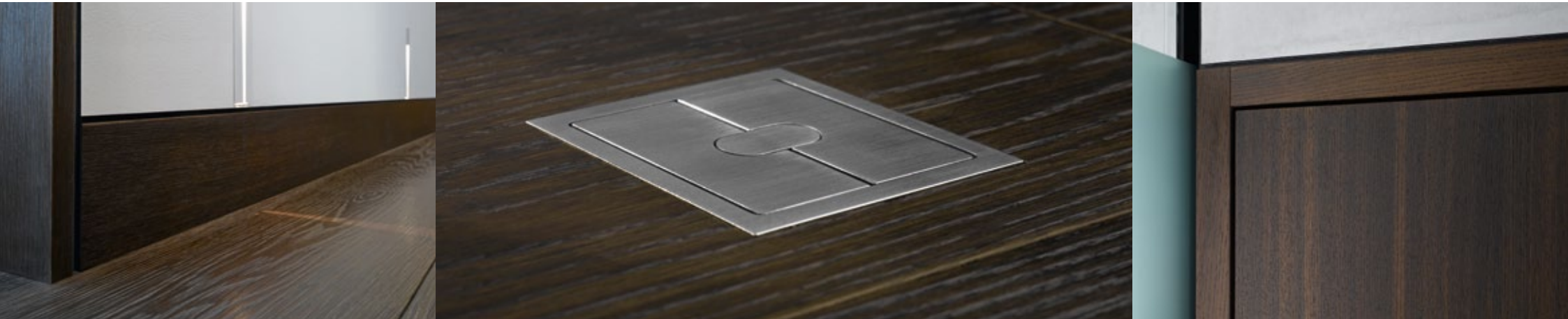

Because every detail is vital: precision



Perfectly designed transitions from one material to another, ideally proportioned joints, exact final finish to the wall – the coherent total appearance of a room is created by the sum of apparently insignificant details.

Our work for a villa in Munich is only one example that shows how it is not only large design elements such as walls, floors or stairs that determine the effect of a room, but also floor boxes with openings for cable connection or convector grids.

These details are not consciously noticed but the discreet way in which they are integrated can be clearly felt in the sophisticated, high-quality and harmonious total impression given by a property.



FURNITURE

When furniture becomes a design object: Milano Table and Fractal Shelves



Is it the illusion of floating unity? Is it the restrained language of the forms? Or is it the tension between textured wood and glass?

The Milano table was designed exclusively for Schotten & Hansen by the designer and architect Francisco Cortina. It is a particularly expressive spatial element. The Fractal bookshelves – another design by Francisco Cortina – are enchanting because of their particular proportions. Supports that widen towards the floor and different wood surfaces: a combination that breathes one hundred per cent harmony into the room.
